Greetings Brothers,

This month I would like to discuss topics related to the third, or Master Mason Degree in Freemasonry. As we began our journey prior to becoming an Entered Apprentice we developed ourselves into "good men." We felt a sense of longing for something that was missing in our lives and the urge to improve ourselves spiritually by attaining such knowledge that could help us transform into that most etheric person that could be compared to the divine; but never achieving such a lofty status. Well, if you are reading this you are less than 1% of the world's population that earned the privilege to obtain the knowledge. In the third and last degree in the Blue Lodge, we learned to become the master of ourselves. This doesn't mean we actually did it but we received the instructions on how to pursue this noble task. We learn this mastery by understanding that our 'will' should be controlled in such a manner as to have a singular purpose and not turn it against ourselves. When the lower parts of man gain leverage over the higher; when what he truly is, is not exemplified, and what he does he would not do then we are divided. This inner rebellion is what makes it impossible for us to have self-mastery. Remember that our 'will' can provide us with that power to help us transcend towards being an enlightened spirit aligning ourselves with the G.A.O.T.U.'s purpose and become like him. Thus, the third degree is all about controlling our 'will' and uniting it towards being a singular spirit and a master of ourselves.

The Temple Legend is the symbol of human life being made perfect. Remember how the SD is taking you through the path of the 'Widow's Son,' as was his custom at High Twelve to go to the unfinished Sanctum Santorum and pray. We should be asking ourselves, why is our Grand Master going to an unfinished Sanctum Santorum to pray? It could be taken literally that he being a holy man wanted to give thanks to his Deity and wanted to be efficient and not leave the Temple to save time. Let us look at this from a more enlightened perspective; the temple is never finished in our morality play because we never quite complete our temple not made with hands, eternal in the heavens. We are constantly trying to improve ourselves. Thus, we can stipulate that the unfinished Sanctum Santorum is anywhere we can meditate, pray, and reflect. Now, after prayer he would draw designs that would allow the builders of the temple to pursue their labors the next day. What is this trying to tell us? We can again take it in literal form and say that the Grand Master being the chief architect drew the designs the day before and left them ready for the craft to make it so! Can you imagine any architect piecemealing his designs daily? Well as you can see that is not only illogical but not worthy of further comment. Thus, the Widow's Son is praying to our G.A.O.T.U. for insights into improving himself and developing a spiritual design to manifest his 'will' towards achieving that level of etheric composition that makes himself better man and transform his spiritual building towards a more perfect building. Since we are representing H.A. in this scene we are learning that prayer, meditation, and/or reflection is the basis for the transformation process in designing that spiritual building.

We now move to the three gates leading to the demise of our Widow's Son. In the first gate he is accosted by a ruffian wilding a 24-inch gauge. The ruffian attempted to extort the Secret Word from H.A. but his refusal led to an attempt to take his life by way of the measuring device. Now, it is possible to take the life of someone with a measuring instrument, but it is unlikely that the meaning is so simple since the strike was to the throat. Thus, there is a deeper meaning to this attempt. Let us analyze the strike to the throat. What does the throat contain; other than the arteries and veins, esophagus, and windpipe. Well, it contains the voice box that allows us to be above the mere animals. Thus, it is permissible to state that the first ruffian is making efforts to take away our voice. The ability to communicate in sound to others. No more could we harmonize the words to achieve further convevance of enlightenment.

The next gate is met by the second ruffian who makes the same levels of extorsion and after being refused takes steps to take the 'Widow's Son's' life by using a square and cutting the Master's breast. The square could have been made of iron and sharpened to penetrate the skin but unlikely. Thus, what is the meaning of this second attempt at the Master's life? The breast can be said to be symbolic of containing the repository of our faith, our hope, and emotions. The second ruffian was attempting to squash our faith and hopes for our humanity and improvements. What a horrid possibility to be without faith and hope.

We now arrive at the third gate where the last ruffian causes the actual demise of our Widow's Son by using a setting maul and hitting his head with it. The maul can most likely cause such traumatic injury as to kill any person. But is this really the purpose of the teachings of our last gate? Yes, the Master did not give up the word because he had the highest of integrity. That is the obvious and important teaching we can derive from this third gate experience. Is this the only philosophical teachings derived from this gate? Well, let's dissect the importance of the interaction between the last ruffian and the Master Architect. After being demanded for the Master's Word the ruffian is told that he needs to wait until the Temple's completion and if found worthy he could receive it. But until the Temple's completion he cannot have the Word. This is interesting because this is a similar message that was provided to the second ruffian. The meaning of this message can be taken literally about the building of the Temple of Solomon but remember that all of Freemasonry is about symbols and allegories to hide the true message, yes? message? We can go back to the First Degree and remember What then is the meaning of the that we are endeavoring to build a spiritual building. Thus, our search for the Word is not available to any Mason until the Temple is complete. If this was the case then there would be no Master Masons working on the Temple, only Fellows and Apprentices. But what does our lectures say? Thus, we may take on the more philosophical approach and identify the message with controlling our 'will' and transforming it from a divided to an undivided focus leading to our spiritual transformation. The final lesson of the gates is how the Widow's Son was murdered by the third assailant. The head is the container of our brain and the mind function. It is the active principle of the repository of our knowledge. Thus, by destroying the brain we are destroying our ability to think. Thus, marks the death of the person's ability to continue the journey of enlightenment and spiritual growth. This is true death when not of the body.

We must then learn to guard against ourselves and external forces that keep taking our time (24-inch gauge) and constraint our speech, attempt at taking away our hope and faith in our mission of self-improvement and helping others achieve the same, and of all that is attempting to prevent our attainment of light by impacting our minds with confusion. Stay focused my Brothers and let the light illuminate your path to controlling the 'will.'

I am hopeful that this brief discussion was useful in harnessing your knowledge of the third degree and focusing it towards a perspective that will permit your continued personal and spiritual growth in Freemasonry. This coming School of Instructions we will be preparing ourselves for the upcoming installation of officers by training on taking the Craft from labor to refreshment and back to labor as well as balloting. I encourage all that are in the line to come to the instructions to refresh ourselves on these most important rituals.


