To Learn to Subdue our Passions and Improve Ourselves in Masonry

As Masons we are taught numerous principles through forms and allegories, but it is left up to the Mason to personally search for the meanings; and with some coaching and mentoring from adept Brothers become better citizens and inhabitants of the universe. A key question that begs to be asked is, “Can a man... gather together his scattering passions, his errant lusts, his wandering thoughts, his discordant habits, shape them anew, and build them all into a unity” (GL 207, 2007, p. 8). Imagine, we as an institution are taking a “good man” and attempting to transform him into a better man. This is generally accomplished by, “strengthening his character, improving his moral and spiritual outlook, and broadening his mental horizons” (GL 217, 2008, P. 3). We as Masons endeavor to encourage each Brother to develop inside themselves the principles of personal responsibility and righteousness, to give each an understanding of and feeling for its charity and endeavor to encourage the Brother to put these lessons into practice in his daily life. Thus, building a better world by first building oneself into a better man. Lastly, Freemasonry also seeks to enlighten the mind of the man by providing a direction of understandings of the persistence of life through time and eternity (GL 217, 2008, P. 3). If I were to go into the entire forms and rituals of the three degrees, we would be reading a book vs. a simple note from the District Instructor. Thus, I will focus this minor education on some (not all) basic tools of our order.

In the Entered Apprentice Degree, we are introduced to the Ashlars by way of the master’s statement of the working tools of the degree. Associated with the Ashlars is the Common Gavel. As we are taught, it is used by “Operative Masons to break off the corners of rough ashlar, and thus fit it the better for the builder’s use, and is therefore adopted as a symbol in Speculative Masonry, to admonish us of the duty of divesting our minds and consciences of all the vices and impurities of life, thereby fitting our bodies as living stones for that spiritual building not made with hands, eternal in the heavens” (Mackey, 1927, vol. I, p. 290). Note of interest about the Master’s gavel is that according to Mackey (1927) is called Hiram, because, like that architect, it governs the Craft and keeps order in the Lodge, as he did in the Temple. The Ashlars are adopted in two different states, as symbols in the Apprentice Degree. The Rough Ashlar, or stone in its crude form, is representative of man’s natural state—ignorant, uncultivated, and vicious. The second Ashlar is the stone in perfect form and is represented as the Perfect Ashlar. Its meaning is man’s personal transformation by way of education exerting its wholesome influence in expanding his intellect, restraining his passions, and purifying his life. Thus, the purpose of the common gavel and the Ashlars is to demonstrate to the Entered Apprentice the road towards his improvement.

In the Fellow Craft, the we are introduced to the Plumb, Square, and Level. In Speculative Masonry the Plumb is a symbol of rectitude of conduct and

inculcates that integrity of life and undeviating course of moral uprightness which can alone distinguish the good and just man. As we erect that spiritual building it is done through strict observance of that plumb-line, which will not permit him to deviate a hair’s breadth to the right or to the left, so we are guided by the unerring principles of right and truth inculcated in its symbolic teachings (Mackey, 1927, vol. II, p. 870). The Square is the most important and significant symbols in Freemasonry. Operatively, the square is used simply to try the correctness of the right angles of a stone-mason, with the angle being of ninety degrees. Speculatively, the Square is a symbol of morality. It is represented to the neophyte as one of the three great lights; to the Fellow as one of his working tools; and to the Master Mason as the official emblem of the Master of the Lodge. It inculcates the same lesson of morality, truthfulness, and honesty. Lastly, the level is speculatively a symbol of equality; not of that social equality which would destroy all distinctions of rank and position, and beget confusion, insubordination, and anarchy; but of that fraternal equality that in the sight of the G.A.O. T.U. move upon that same plane. Thus, this teaches us that all men are equal, subject to the same infirmities, hastening to the same goal, and preparing to be judged by the same immutable law. In other words, “we are traveling upon the Level of Time, toward that undiscovered country from whose bourne no traveler returns” (Mackey, 1927, vol. II, p. 570; Florida Masonic Monitor, 2015, p. 68). It should be noted that this last sentence regarding the level is from Hamlet, Act 111, Scene I, and no! Shakespeare was not a Freemason. By the way the word bourne means boundary and it is no longer used in common English. Additionally, the undiscovered country is interpreted as death. Thus, when restated in our common language, we are traveling upon the Level of Time, towards death from whose boundaries no man returns. There is quite a lot of information in this one line that we should reflect much upon, but don’t let yourself get confused since “man” is not the “soul” but the corporeal version of the ethereal (hint). I will leave the rule and trowel for another day of learning and reflections.

Thus, let us come to our Open Books every first Wednesday and third Monday of each month, at Doric Lodge, and learn our rich rituals that means so much more than the words and floor work. I encourage each Master of their Lodge to bring their Entered Apprentices and Fellow Crafts (accompanied) to learn their catechisms. I also encourage each Senior Warden to bring their future lines to Open Books to improve upon the opening and closing of the Lodge and inculcate the meaning of the rich symbolism of the floor works and statements. From the light rising in the East, by way of the meridian, regenerating through the light of the West back to the East, I wish all a contemplative and healthy October.

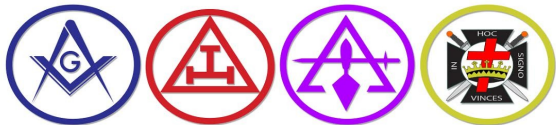
