Greetings to all my Brothers,

This past 26th Masonic District School of Instructions was well served with our ever-increasing number of Brothers eager to learn their ritual work. We had a total of 37 Brothers attend and learn their catechism, esoteric works for the degrees, floor work, and generally be with their Brothers. I am pleased with this level of enthusiasm and encourage all the Brothers to come and join us in our ever-growing movement of becoming proficient in our ritual work.

This past Monday, we went over the Master Mason Degree, second section. We learned quite a bit and corrected many of the floor work issues thanks to our more adept Brothers. This is not a one Brother show but a conglomerate of adepts that are highly interested in our Fraternity's future and provide all of us with the knowledge needed to keep us in the path of light. Thus, I invite all Freemasons to come and join us the first Wednesday and third Monday of each month to Open Books at Doric Lodge.

Now let us visit the Enter Apprentice Degree and the rite of destitution. This is where a candidate confesses to being poor and helpless as well as blind. The rite of destitution generally covers the concept of placing our past actions and putting them aside or "off" (GL203 Booklet, 1994). When we find ourselves without there is a voluntary renunciation of our old life, and all that would prevent us from entering our new life of a Freemason is left behind. This means we no longer look at our honors, badges, and various distinctions. We all come into the lodge on the level. Now, before we entered the Lodge to become Entered Apprentices, we were supposed to be properly prepared. This concept is a lot more than we may give credit to. It is not simply signing the form and going through the motions of the degree. There is quite a lot of preparing that takes place.

The individual(s) knocking at the door, requesting entrance, and being avouched for by a Brother had to go through some mentoring as prescribed by the Grand Lodge of Florida. This prepares the candidate in achieving a clearer meaning of Freemasonry when receiving the rituals. The candidate must be prepared not only in the physical form but also in the mental and spiritual. After all, our transformation take place in that place within us all that dictates our thoughts and actions.

The keeper of the door asks the avouched if this is action, he is about to go through is his true desire. There can be no coercion or promised remuneration for entering our fraternity since the knowledge imparted must be willingly sought. Next comes another important question; this is one of being eligible to receive the degree (actual words are esoteric and cannot be disclosed; come to Open Books and remember the lines). What does this mean? Each Lodge is afforded the responsibility to screen their candidates in proper fashion to ensure they are bringing in someone that is not only the right fit for the Lodge but also wishes to go into the unknown and learn to be a better person. There is no specific method of doing this but getting to know the candidate, the people he hangs around with, his family, and if he can meet his financial needs to himself, family, and the Lodge is a good start. Another review is the moral tendencies of the candidate. In other words, our mission is to make good men better; not to make bad men into good men. Thus, this is where we say, "guard the West Gate."

Thus, my Brothers let us reflect on this segment of the Entered Apprentice Degree and learn from the hidden meanings regarding our cognitive and spiritual development. To learn more, I encourage you to come by Doric Lodge when we have Open Books and feel free to be enlightened on this grand journey, we all embarked in. As a Fraternity we cannot provide the guidance of improving others if we ourselves do not learn the methods, techniques, and are willing to impart such knowledge. See all you real soon, now.


